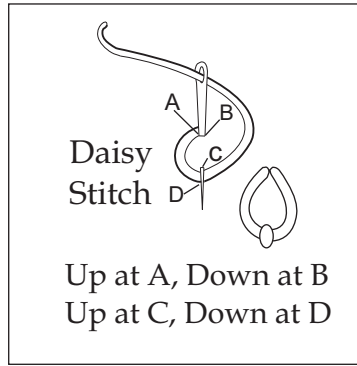

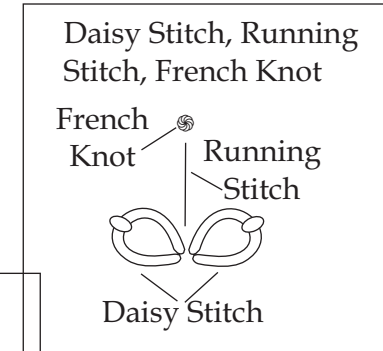

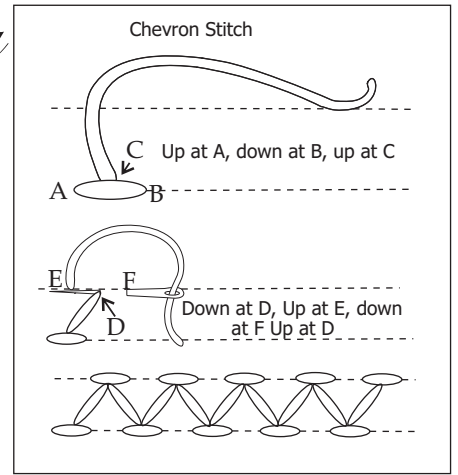

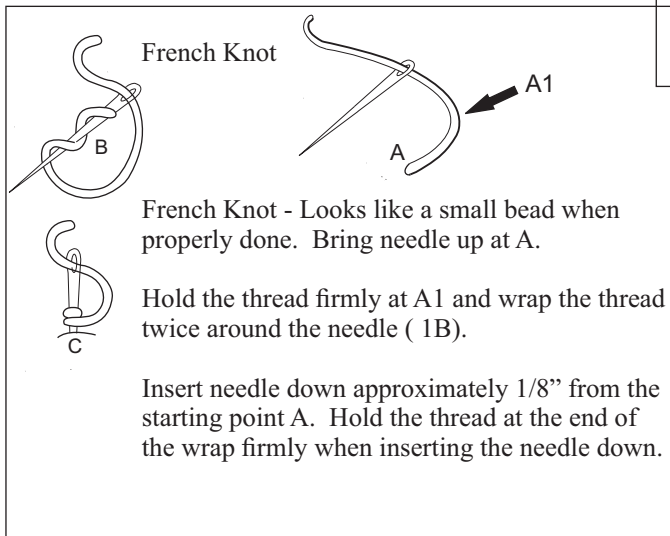

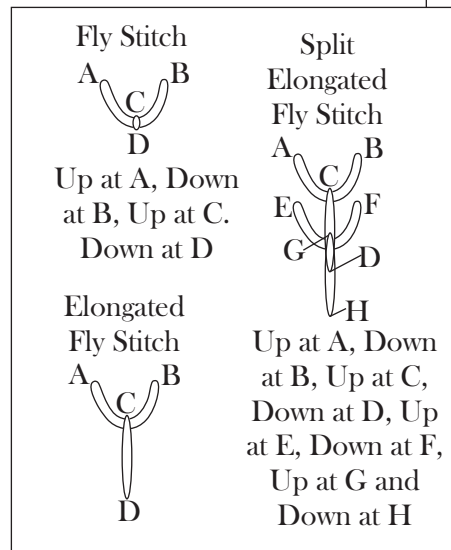


French Knot

French Knot - Looks like a small bead when properly done. Bring needle up at A.

Hold the thread firmly at A1 and wrap the thread twice around the needle ( 1B).

Insert needle down approximately 1/8" from the starting point A. Hold the thread at the end of the wrap firmly when inserting the needle down.

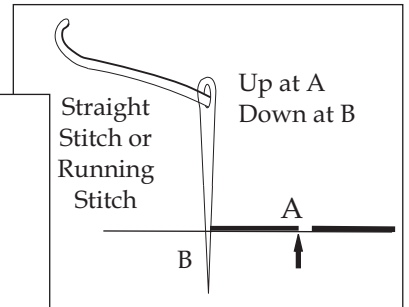

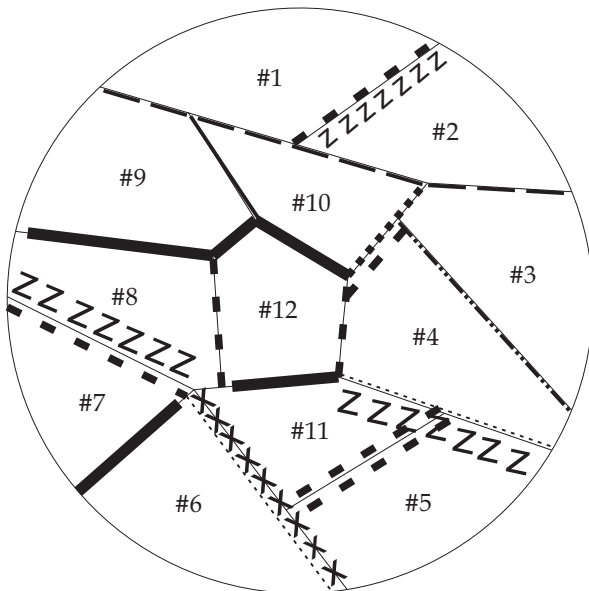
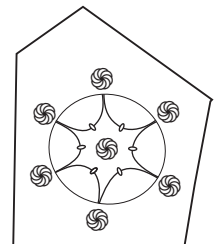
